A presentation was made before Council during the regular meeting of September 13, 2016, by an association representative who requested financial assistance for the replacement of the Cardiff Hall floor. The Community Service Advisory Board (CSAB) met on Monday, October 3, 2016.

Community Service Advisory Board was duly granted the authority to review the request and make a recommendation to Council. Council supports the meaningful engagement of their Boards and recognizes the value of the community perspective that the community representative share as part of the consultation. The Board's recommendation is supported by Administration. Council has the discretion to accept or reject the recommendation for any political reason leading to their conclusion.
